- 1. Heat Exchanger- Will be inspected for cracks and deterioration. **CO test included on PCSA plan**.
- 2. Air Filter- Will be replaced at time of maintenance (standard sizes included).
- 3. Burners- Will be inspected and cleaned.
- 4. Thermocouple or HSI- Will be inspected for wear.
- 5. Pilot or Flame Rod- Clean and adjust.
- 6. Fan Switch- Inspected and adjusted as needed.
- 7. Safety Controls-Will be operationally checked.
- 8. Blower wheel- Inspect motor and lubricate bearings.
- Gas Line- Will be leak-checked from the furnace shut-off valve to the burners.
- 10. Combustion Air- Openings will be checked for blockage.
- 11. Secure All Panels- Loose panels increase operating costs and can cause dangerous operating conditions.
- Thermostat- Clean and check for proper operation.
- 13. Make necessary recommendations.



- 1. Air Filter-Will be replaced (std sizes).
- 2. Condensing Coil-Inspect for leaks and wash.
- 3. Evaporator Coil-Inspect if accessible.
- 4. Blower Wheel- Inspect for cleanliness and alignment. Lubricate as needed.
- 5. Refrigerant Charge- Check superheat and subcooling. Verify proper Freon charge.
- 6. Belts and Pulleys-Will be inspected and adjusted.
- 7. Lubrication of motors and bearings.
- 8. Thermostat-Clean and check for proper operation.
- 9. Controls and Safeties-Inspect and test.
- 10. Motors- Cleaned, oiled and inspected.
- 11. Capacitors-Inspect and test.
- 12. Condensate Drain- Line will be checked to assure it's open and draining water.
- 13. Crankcase Heater-Will be operationally checked.
- 14. Relays and Contactors-Will be inspected.
- 15. Unit Disconnect- Will be inspected. Worn disconnects are dangerous and blow fuses.
- 16. Unit Wiring- Inspect for degradation. Inspect and tighten loose connections.

Heat pumps will receive all of the A/C services listed in 1-16, PLUS:

- 17. Defrost Timer- checked and tested.
- Reversing Valve- Operationally checked. An improperly operating reversing valve wastes energy and reduces heating output.
